- A. In order to assign a code for ISSUEA or BILL, you first need to determine which of the following ten categories is most appropriate for the issue or bill mentioned in the story:
 - 1. Appropriations, Authorizations, and Programmatic Expenditures
 - 2. Budget, Tax, and Macroeconomic Policy
 - 3. Defense and Foreign Policy
 - 4. Economic Regulation, Commerce, and Trade Policy
 - 5. Environmental, Energy, and Science Policy
 - 6. Governmental Operations and Congressional Affairs
 - 7. Education and Labor Policy
 - 8. Health and Welfare Policy
 - 9. Law, Justice, Immigration, and Civil Rights Policy
 - 10. Miscellaneous Policies and Omnibus Legislation
- B. Within each category, you should first check to see if the policy issue is one of the 31 "Key Votes." All Key Votes have an asterisk as a prefix and are followed by a K number. If appropriate, assign the corresponding 3-digit code number.
- C. If no Key Vote is appropriate, then check the list of specific issues that have no prefixes. If one of these is appropriate, assign the corresponding 3-digit code numbers.
- D. If the list of specific issues does not work, then consult the list of general issues that are preceded by an exclamation point. Assign an appropriate 3-digit code.
- E. The whole process is repeated to assign a code for ISSUEB and ISSUEC.
- F. As reminders that abortion, budget balancing, "Contract with America," crime, gays in the military, gun control, health reform, and NAFTA require extra coding, I have placed two-letter abbreviations for these policy issues (AB, BU, CN, CR, GA, GU, HL, NA) in front of several 3-digit codes.
